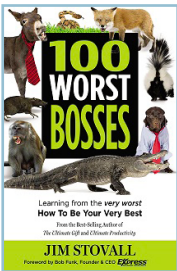

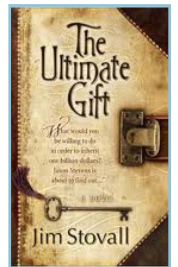
JIM STOVALL
